


# CorreTrak Web 2.7.6

## Release Notes

### Enhancements

#### 1 Enhancement – Reconciling Full Counts

With the introduction of the roster based Full Count CorreTrak Web users will see that there are extra or missing inmates in that location. New functionality has been added to reconcile a full count, the CorreTrak Web user will be able to include or exclude inmates who were unexpected or not present due to a temporary release/absence. In addition, Web users will see a count of all inmates on temp release in that count location.





#### 2 Enhancement – Specifying Count Types Available for Mobile Users

Within the System settings menu Web users now can indicate if only Quick Count, Full Count, or both count types are available for Mobile users to select. Mobile users will receive a message that the disabled count has been turned off by the administrator.

#### 3 Enhancement – Associating Multiple QR Codes with a Single Location

In the Code Table section of the System Settings there is now a menu that gives Web users the ability to assign existing QR codes to a single location. This relates to the functionality described in item 2 of the CorreTrak 2.7.6 Mobile release notes - specifically, allowing any QR code to be assigned to a jail location to facilitate scanning locations in the mobile app.

## Bug Fixes

### **1 Bug Fix – Inmates in custody appeared as out of custody**

Resolved an issue for GTL OMSe sites, where occasionally, an update to an inmate’s historical record in OMSe would cause a synchronization issue, resulting in the current inmate booking record being marked inactive.

### **2 Transaction Review Error**

Selecting a large amount of data under the Transaction Review page (under Rounds Review) produced an error that prevented the user from viewing the data. A fix has been included to prevent this error, regardless of the size of the data requested.

### **3 Rounds Checks Falsely Appear As Late In Rounds Dashboard**

Resolved an issue where Rounds locations assigned an interval schedule that spanned midnight would appear as “Late” on the Rounds dashboard almost immediately after updating the dashboard. The Rounds dashboard now correctly reflects these rounds checks as on time.

### **4 Items Were Not Indicated As Received In Inmate Dashboard**

Items received from an inmate in the Service Delivery module were not being indicated in the inmate’s Inmate Dashboard profile. Now when an item is received a blue “Received” note will appear for the item in the Inmate Dashboard.
